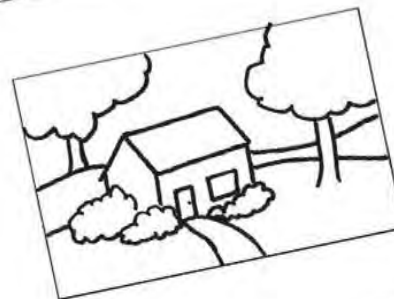
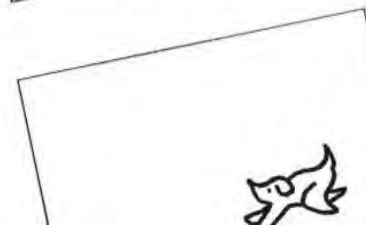
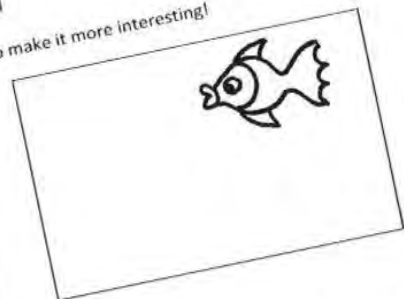
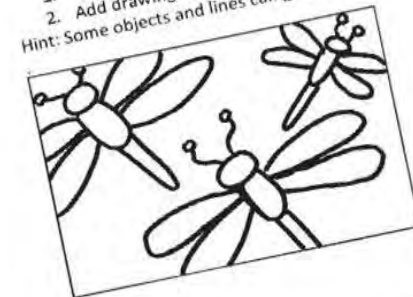
Objectives: Students will...

The Building Blocks of Artwork
ELEMENTS OF ART

POSITIVE SPACE: The most subject of the artwork.

NEGATIVE SPACE: The SPACE around the main subject of the art.

Space

Space is the area in and around objects in a work of art.

Space

- Successful artwork uses space well.
- Ways to use space well are:
 - Moving large and small objects
 - Dividing up the space with objects.
 - Having lines and objects going off all 4 edges of the artwork.

- Look at the different size objects in the picture.

Space

- Look how the space is divided up.

- Look how objects and lines go off all edges.
