




Today:

- Use the magic color change markers to add lines and geometric patterns on top.

Today:

- Cut out your blobs.
- Wrap them around your finger to curve them.
- Glue two sides down, holding them to your paper and counting to 10 to help them stick.
- Make sure part of your blob is sticking off of the paper to create a relief sculpture.
- Attach all your blobs to your construction paper.
- Start on the early finisher activity.

RELIEF COLLAGE CHECKLIST

Drew organic shaped blobs.

- Filled the blobs with color, lines, and geometric shapes.
- Cut up close to the edge of the blobs to cut them out.
- Curved the blobs around finger to curve them.
- Used just two dots of glue to glue each blob to a new sheet of paper.
- The construction paper is filled up.
 - The organic shape blobs curve off of the paper to create a relief sculpture.




