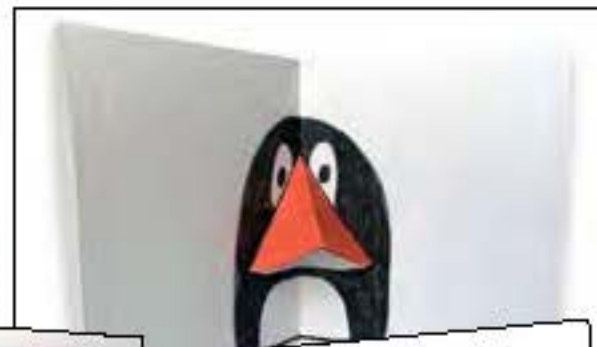

Teacher notes, presentations, demo videos included to help you guide the projects. No experience is needed!

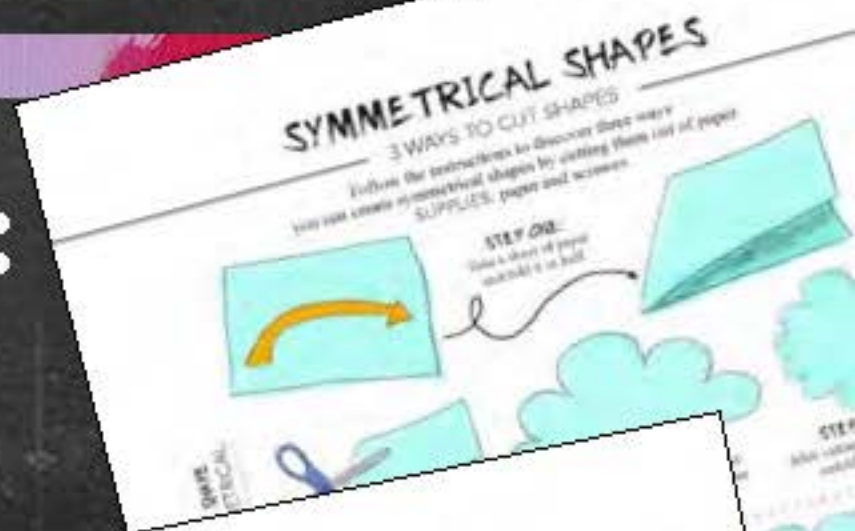

SYMMETRICAL COLLAGE

PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions below to complete your symmetrical collage work of art.

SUPPLIES: construction paper in a variety of colors, glue, scissors, hole puncher

TIP: Start with your larger shapes and add smaller shapes on top.

STEP ONE: Gather your supplies.

STEP TWO: Take your color paper and cut it in half with the hole puncher.

STEP THREE: Use a smaller sheet of paper to cut out the shape.

STEP FOUR: Glue it on the other half of your shape. Add the hole puncher to the other side.

STEP FIVE: Use your hole puncher to punch a hole in the paper.

STEP SIX: Repeat the process with different colors and shapes.

SYMMETRICAL SHAPES

2 WAYS TO CUT SHAPES

Follow the instructions to discover two ways to create symmetrical shapes by cutting them out of paper.

SUPPLIES: paper and scissors

STEP ONE: Take a sheet of paper and fold it in half.

STEP TWO: Use scissors to cut out the shape.

TIP: The cut should go all the way through the folded edge of your paper.

STEP THREE: Use your scissors to cut out the shape.

CREATING SHAPES THAT ARE SYMMETRICAL

SYMMETRICAL DRAWING

DRAWING GUIDE

Follow the instructions to create a symmetrical drawing.

SUPPLIES: pencil, paper, hole puncher, hole punch

STEP ONE: Take a sheet of paper and fold it in half.

STEP TWO: Draw a shape on one side of the paper.

STEP THREE: Use your hole puncher to punch a hole in the paper.

STEP FOUR: Use your hole puncher to punch a hole in the other side of the paper.

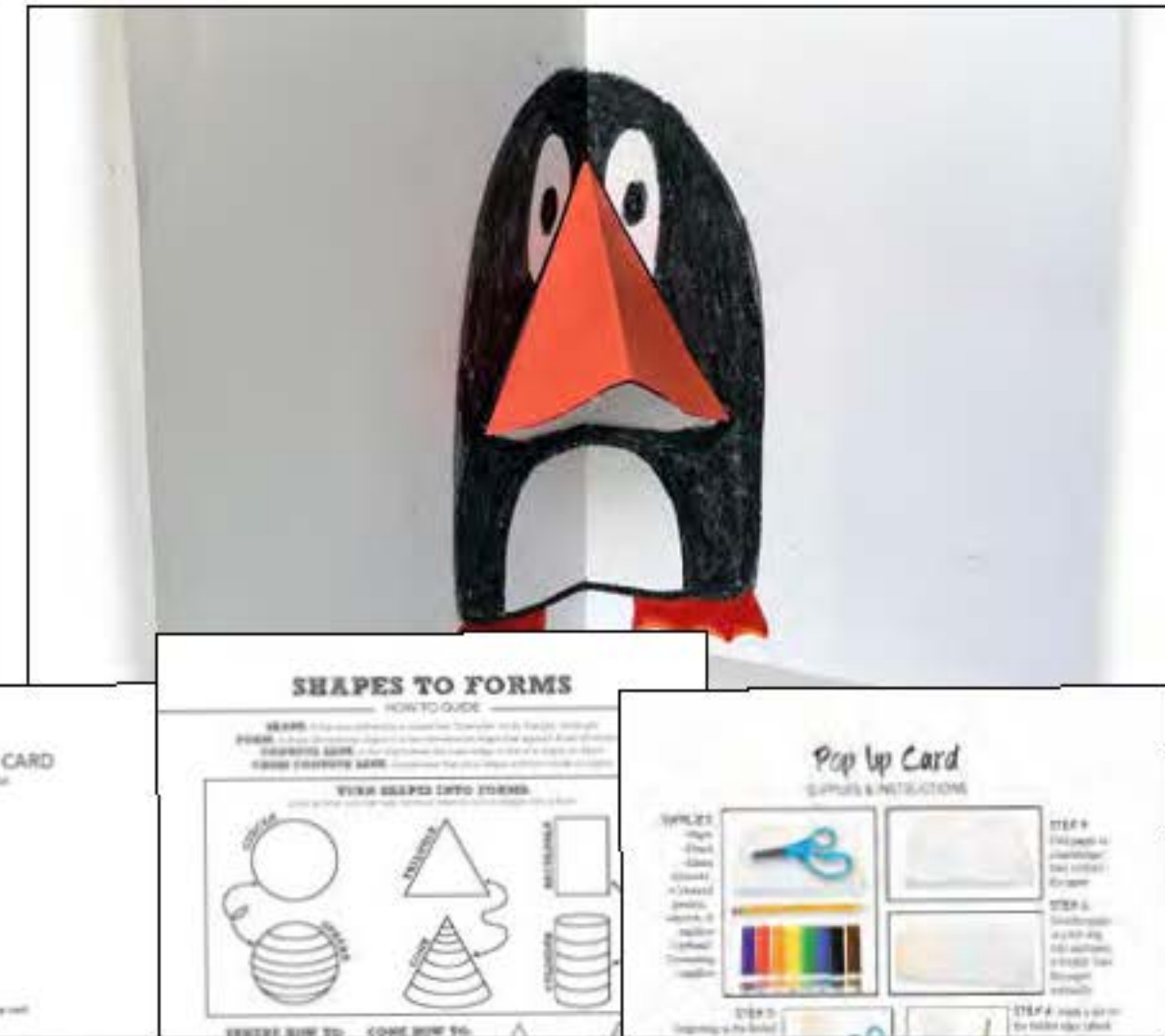
