

Age Group: 3rd Grude and up

Artist Exemplar. Egyptian art

Big Idea: Personalizing at history

# Essential Questions:

- What is symbolism?
- What are characteristics of an Egyptian sarcoplingus?
- How can you create personal artwork?

#### I can...

- Learn about Egyptian art history.
- Design my own Egyptian sarcophagus
- include symbols and colors that represent me
- Take care of supplies and clean up after myself.

# Objective: Students will

Learn about Egyptian art, including literoglyplacs, symbolism, and sarcophagus

# Teacher Notes

### SCAFFOLING:

Students will build upon past knowledge of the elements of art and principles of design as they learn about and apply ways to achieve unity and contrast through the use of pattern and color.

# TEACHING TIPS:

- Choose to make this project a short or long one depending on what size
- If drawn on light tan paper this project makes a nice art show entry or part of a Egyptian artwork display.
- This works well as an early finishers project for the Egyptian Cartonche printmaking project or can be a stand-alone project.
- If making a large sarcophagus template cut out and trace around the pattern on thin cardboard to make patterns for each table.
- Allow students to choose symbols and colors outside of the Egyptian meaning. For example, they add a basketball or dog because they feel they are symbolic to them.

CHECKLIST

	Optional: traced the sarcophagus template on a sheet of paper.
	Added a face to the design.
	Added a headdress, hair, or similar decoration around the face.
	Added curving, smile lines to create stripes.
-	Added patterns to some of the stripes.
-	Lines shapes and colors are repeated to create patterns.
	Dicked symbols to add to personalize the design and symbolism
	Added color to your design, selected colors based on meaning.
	The color helps to emphasize the pattern in the design.
	Optional: Worked on an early finisher activity.
	Cared for supplies and cleaned up after yourself.







