Teacher Notes

I love to ease into January with this mural project which fills empty spaces and bulletin boards around the school after holiday decorations have been taken down.

- MURAL TIPS:
 - If the blue paper is in good shape when the snowman is filled with toilet paper add white roll paper for the ground:
 - Cut along the lower outline of the snowman's bottom circle.
 - Cut a strip of white roll paper (same width as blue paper).
 - Slide cut the edge of the white paper under the bottom circle and glue it to the blue paper.
 - Scarf: Cut along the outline on either side of the snowman's neck, push the end of the scarf through and tape on the back. Tie the scarf in front, gluing ends where the snowman or on the background paper to make it look like it's blowing in the wind.
 - You can also cut a scarf shape out of construction paper and glue it to the snowman rather than wrapping it around the snowman and tying it.
 - Arms: draw them on paper with marker and cut them out as...

HEART PRINT

HOW TO GUIDE

Follow the steps below to create a one-of-a-kind heart print.



STEP ONE: Create 4 different designs that include a heart, lines, and shapes to make patterns. **TIP:** Try different sizes, vertical, and horizontal designs. Fill the space up!



STEP TWO: When you are ready to start on scratch foam, grab your supplies and start by writing your name on the back lightly with a marker.



STEP THREE: Draw your design on the scratch foam using a dull pencil. Use medium pressure, if you press too hard you can cut through the foam.



STEP FOUR: Go over your design with your pencil eraser to get...



STEP FIVE: Make sure no space in your design is thinner than the width of your pencil or smaller than your pencil eraser.

- The elements of art include:
 - Line
 - Shape

LINE

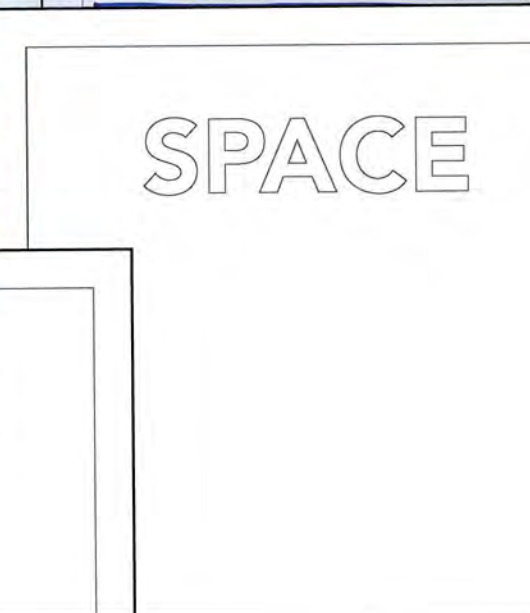
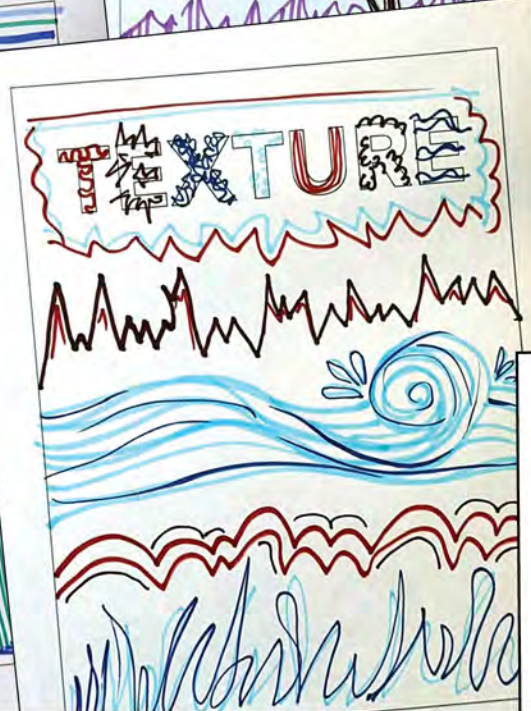
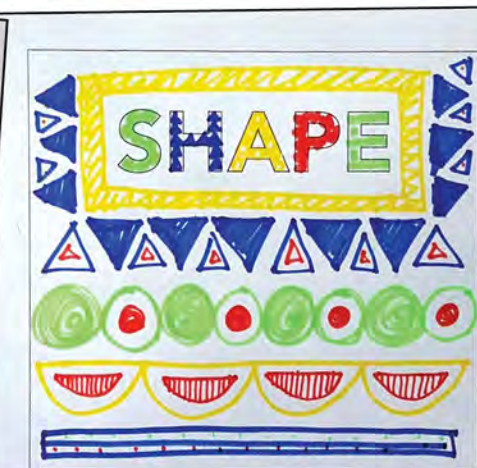
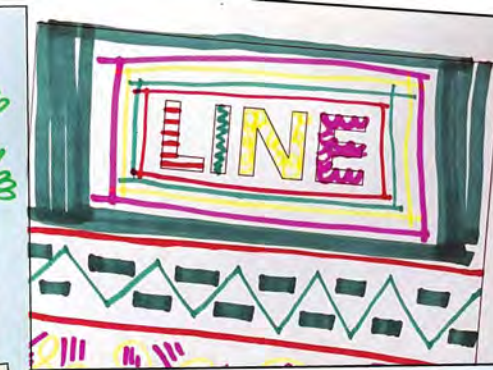
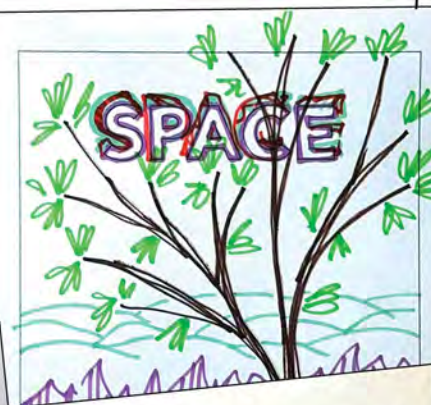
- Line is a mark that is longer than it is wide.
- Line can be used to create the outline of a subject, add a pattern, create texture, a sense of value, and more.
- Type of line include:
 - Horizontal
 - Vertical
 - Diagonal
 - Curved
 - and so on

COLOUR

- Colours can be grouped in the colour wheel to create colour schemes.
 - Complementary colours are colours across from each other on the colour wheel. They create a strong contrast when placed next to each other.
- Example: blue and orange, red and green, yellow and purple
